

**Elementary:**

All Elementary schools met at Sunnyside to discuss student achievement goals. We discussed the use of Nested goals and the assessment pyramid to streamline the data collection needed to measure student achievement. Each grade level developed an assessment pyramid using common assessments to enable staff to follow student progress across the district.

**Lincoln Middle School & Pullman High School:**
