Meeting Minutes

Review meeting minutes from January 11, 2022

• ELD Parent Engagement event updates

• ELD staff reported that due to impact of covid it would be a challenge to begin coordinating at this time. This event will unfortunately not happen this year but is planned for next year.

Family Survey

- o Family surveys have been returned to the district office and are ready for review.
- Discussion was opened on how survey results will be shared. There was a suggestion that results could be shared during the upcoming April family night. Other potential avenues posting results on the district website and submitted in the superintendent's weekly family newsletter. There is district office staff on hand that can be potential sources for help on graphics presentation of charts.
- Survey results can be formatted as charts with written summary. Use OSPI guidelines on what four points to be shared with data. A draft will be submitted for review by the committee after spring break in April prior to posting.
- In the future, plan on using paper surveys over online format as it is more efficient for having form translated. Family surveys typically are handed out to families in October around fall conferences.

• ELD website update

- ELD staff presented proposed updates for the ELD page on the district website. Information and links needed to be updated due to change to the WIDA. Programs models have also changed.
- It was suggested we have an explanation of what GLAD and SIOP is specifically and that inserting a
 hyperlink in the document to those sources could be used.
- o District office staff will move forward with having updates posted on website.

Other
