Classes & CTSO Update

What is going well and what needs to be improved?

Currently about 48 members, up a few from last year. We have held 2 chapter meetings so far with a great turnout. Rolling out practices a little each week, planning on having more of a regular schedule starting next week. Our greenhand appreciation dessert will be 11/7 @ 5:30pm.

State is still in Kennewick, same format but with more spaces reserved and supposedly a shuttle.

Classes: 121 students this year. In Biology we have been looking at evolution with antibiotic and herbicide resistance, as well as Creed speaking. Physical science has been working on Thermal Energy with moving into building a heat engine, and had an Agricultural issues unit as well. Vet Science has been focusing on anatomy and physiology with a dissection coming up in about 3 weeks (22 students in the class!). Plant science just finished up a soils unit, including a field trip to WSU soils lab. Starting a project on hydroponics.

Improvement: need to set up the next set of field trips to include Vet Sci & Plan Sci; get members organized for practice schedule, incorporate advocacy more about our program including both class and FFA.
