ENROLLMENT IN THE CPP

Enrollment in the CPP is optional. The CPP cost for Chromebooks is \$5 (non-refundable) per year, per student that covers the <u>first accidental</u> damage.

Damage by gross negligence and willful destruction are not covered.

WHY PURCHASE THE CPP?

The total replacement cost of a district-issued Chromebook provided to students can cost up to \$300. Purchasing the CPP can reduce liability for the student and their family if the Chromebook needs repaired.

- THEFT OF A CHROMEBOOK (IF POLICE REPORT DEEMS IT STOLEN PROPERTY)
- **STATE OF THE PROOF OF THE PROO**
- MISSING KEYS/DAMAGED KEYBOARD
- CRACKED BEZEL/CASE

WHAT'S NOT COVERED?

- THEFT OF A CHROMEBOOK WITHOUT A POLICE REPORT
- **LOST CHROMEBOOK**
- MISSING OR DAMAGED CHARGERS
- LIQUID DAMAGE
- WILLFUL DESTRUCTION AND GROSS NEGLIGENCE
