The employee's plan may include attendance at one training, conference, seminar, or similar. The employee's request for training must be aligned with their position, meet the current or expected needs of the district, and be tied to evaluation criteria. The supervisor may refuse an employee's request if it does not meet the needs of the district, or there are budgetary constraints. If a supervisor denies a request, the employee may submit a revised request for a different or lower cost training, including virtual attendance in lieu of physical.
