WIDA is a 40-state consortium that promotes educational equity for multilingual learners through language development standards, assessments, and high-quality professional learning for P-12 educators.						
WIDA Screener for Kindergarten and WIDA Screener	Grades K - 12	Aug. 1, 2022 – June 25, 2023 Administered no later than the student's 30 th day of attendance (through 12/31/2022)	Required for newly enrolled students who first learned or actively speak a language other than English at home, as well as newly enrolled Native American students who are academically at risk. K is only offered via paper/pencil, 1-12 is online			
WIDA ACCESS Annual Test Assesses language proficiency growth of Multilingual learners. • Reading • Listening • Writing • Speaking	Grades K - 12	January 30-March 24	Required annually for all qualified Multilingual Learners.			
WIDA Alternative ACCESS	Grades K-12	January 30-March 24	Students with significant cognitive disabilities may participate in this assessment as an alternative to WIDA ACCESS for the purpose of meeting the annual requirement for all qualified Multilingual Learners.
